## Overview:

**TODAY'S GAME ...** The Silver Hawks look to avoid a season opening series sweep against Bowling Green. Both starters make their MWL debuts tonight at Bowling Green Ballpark. **John Pedrotty** is the first left-handed starter to throw for South Bend this season.

**UP NEXT ...** After an offday on Easter Sunday, the Silver Hawks begin a seven-game homestand. It all commences on Monday when the Hawks host the **Fort Wayne TinCaps** for the home opener at **Coveleski Stadium**. First pitch is slated for 7:05 p.m. EST. On the homestand, the Hawks host Fort Wayne for the first three and **Dayton** for the final four.

**ABOUT COACHING STAFF ...** Silver Hawks Field Manager **Mark Haley** will skipper the Hawks for an eighth consecutive season. Haley enters this season with 582 career wins. Haley was named Midwest League Manager of the Year in 2005 and 2008. **Bobby Smith** returns for his second season as the Hawks hitting coach. Smith played in parts of five big league seasons with Tampa Bay. **Wellington Cepeda** is back for his sixth season as the Hawks pitching coach and his ninth in the Dbacks organization.

**CHANGES ABOUND ...** The Silver Hawks are now owned and operated by Swing-Batter-Swing LLC whose sole shareholder is **Andrew T. Berlin** of Chicago. Berlin reached an agreement to buy the team in November and the sale was approved in January. Berlin (\$2.25 Million) and the city of South Bend (\$1.75 Million) have invested about **\$4 million** for renovations at Coveleski Regional Stadium.

**RENOVATIONS ...** Changes at **Coveleski Stadium** include eight new **outdoor suites** and a brand new **home plate suite**. Pre-existing indoor suites are being renovated. A **brick facade** will now cover many of the bare concrete walls inside the stadium. A splash pad is being added beyond the right field wall, the synagogue on William St. is being transformed into the team's new **souvenir store**. A **family fun zone** -- with games and inflatables -- is new behind the left-center field fence.

**DIAMONDS ARE FOREVER ...** **Andrew Berlin** announced in March that the **Silver Hawks** and **Arizona Diamondbacks** will maintain affiliation through **September 2014**. The current player development contract was set to expire at the end of this season.

**BASEBALL AMERICA TOP PROSPECTS ...** Right-hander **Archie Bradley** is ranked the No. 2 prospect in the Diamondbacks organization, according to Baseball America. **Tyler Green** (No. 25), **Jesse Darrah** (No. 26) **J.R. Bradley** (No. 27) and **John Pedrotty** (No. 29) are also on the list.

**THE BOYS ARE BACK IN TOWN ...** The Silver Hawks roster includes **ten** returning players: **Bobby Stone**, **Gerson Montilla**, **Matt Helm**, **Niko Gallego**, **Tyson Van Winkle**, **Jeffrey Shields**, **Tyler Green**, **J.R. Bradley**, **Kable Hogben** and **Ender Inciarte**.

**SILVER HAWKS RECORD WATCH ...** **Ender Inciarte** currently ranks sixth on the Silver Hawks career triples list with 13. **Keon Broxton** is the all-time leader with 21. **Matt Helm** currently sits fifth on the Silver Hawks all-time strikeouts (batter) list with 223. **Nilson Robledo** struck out 277 times from 1991-95. **J.R. Bradley** ranks third all-time with 16 pitching losses — **Marc Van Wormer** lost 20 games from 1997-98.

## More Tid Bits:

**BIG FINISH ...** Pedrotty had a terrific August last summer with the Yakima Bears of the Northwest League. In six starts he went 2-2 with a 2.06 ERA in 35 innings. He struck out 37 with just nine walks. He also reeled off five straight quality starts from 8/3 to 8/23.

**NO-HIT OUTING ...** Pedrotty no-hit the Vancouver Canadians through six innings on Aug. 13 in Yakima. He struck out seven and did not allow a run. The Bears shutout the Canadians 3-0.

**SCOUTING REPORT ...** From Baseball America: "[Pedrotty] has a loose arm and a smooth delivery with some deception. He pounds the strike zone and gets some swings and misses with his sinking fastball." In addition to a fastball (88-92 MPH), Pedrotty has a changeup and a "fringy" curveball/slider.

**FORMER HAWKS AROUND BASEBALL ...** Raywilly Gomez went 3-for-4 with a double in Visalia's 9-3 win against Bakersfield. Bobby Borchering was 2-for-5 with two doubles and an RBI. Yazi Arbelo went 1-for-5 with an RBI. Eury De La Rosa got the win in relief for Double-A Mobile last night against Mississippi. Matt Davidson hit third and played 3B for the BayBears and notched a double. Ryan Wheeler started at 3B for the Reno Aces last night and went 0-for-4.

**FILLING IN AT THIRD ...** As Mark Haley continues to recover from and offseason illness, he will begin the season coaching from the dugout. Luis Urueta will fill in as third base coach until Haley returns. Urueta is part of the coaching staff for the Diamondbacks Dominican Summer League team.

**WELL REPRESENTED ...** The Silver Hawks opening day roster features 13 players that spent time with the 2011 Missoula Osprey of the Pioneer League. Pitchers: Archie Bradley, Jesse Darrah, Keith Hessler, D.J. Johnson, Matt Sample, Taylor Siemens and Seth Simmons ... Position Players: Fidel Pena, Josh Parr, Chris Ellison, Ryan Court, Tom Belza and Roidany Aguila.

**THIRD SEASON HAWKS ...** While the Silver Hawks welcome back 10 total players in 2012, four of them will be playing in their third season with the Hawks. Matt Helm (2010-11), Ender Inciarte (2010-11), Tyson Van Winkle (2009-10) and Bobby Stone (2010-11).
