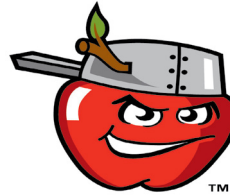

## Overview:

**LAST GAME ...** The Silver Hawks bid for a third straight win fell short as the Fort Wayne TinCaps evened the three game series with a convincing 8-1 win. Fort Wayne exploded in the fourth inning for seven runs and never looked back en route to the win. **J.R. Bradley** allowed eight earned runs on 11 hits over 3.1 innings in his 2012 debut. Temperatures at gametime were in the upper 30s.

**UP NEXT ...** Tomorrow the Silver Hawks welcome the **Dayton Dragons** to town for the first of four games at Coveleski Stadium. Thursday will mark the first of 13 meetings with the Dragons in 2012. The Dragons were a league-best **83-57** in 2011.

**BEAT THE STREAK ...** Last night **Matt Helm** and **Ender Inciarte** recorded basehits to extend their hitting streaks to five games. **Michael Freeman** recorded the Hawks longest hitting streak last season at **15** games. Inciarte hit safely in **11** straight games from 5/29 to 6/9.

**ABOUT COACHING STAFF ...** Silver Hawks Field Manager **Mark Haley** will skipper the Hawks for an eighth consecutive season. Haley enters this season with 582 career wins. Haley was named Midwest League Manager of the Year in 2005 and 2008. **Bobby Smith** returns for his second season as the Hawks hitting coach. Smith played in parts of five big league seasons with Tampa Bay. **Wellington Cepeda** is back for his sixth season as the Hawks pitching coach and his ninth in the Dbacks organization.

**CHANGES ABOUND ...** The Silver Hawks are now owned and operated by Swing-Batter-Swing LLC whose sole shareholder is **Andrew T. Berlin** of Chicago. Berlin reached an agreement to buy the team in November and the sale was approved in January. Berlin (\$2.25 Million) and the city of South Bend (\$1.75 Million) have invested about **\$4 million** for renovations at Coveleski Regional Stadium.

**RENOVATIONS ...** Changes at **Coveleski Stadium** include eight new **outdoor suites** and a brand new **home plate suite**. Pre-existing indoor suites are being renovated. A **brick facade** will now cover many of the bare concrete walls inside the stadium. A splash pad is being added beyond the right field wall, the synagogue on William St. is being transformed into the team's new **souvenir store**. A **family fun zone** -- with games and inflatables -- is new behind the left-center field fence.

**DIAMONDS ARE FOREVER ...** **Andrew Berlin** announced in March that the **Silver Hawks** and **Arizona Diamondbacks** will maintain affiliation through **September 2014**. The current player development contract was set to expire at the end of this season.

**BASEBALL AMERICA TOP PROSPECTS ...** Right-hander **Archie Bradley** is ranked the No. 2 prospect in the Diamondbacks organization, according to Baseball America. **Tyler Green** (No. 25), **Jesse Darrah** (No. 26) **J.R. Bradley** (No. 27) and **John Pedrotty** (No. 29) are also on the list.

**THE BOYS ARE BACK IN TOWN ...** The Silver Hawks roster includes **ten** returning players: **Bobby Stone**, **Gerson Montilla**, **Matt Helm**, **Niko Gallego**, **Tyson Van Winkle**, **Jeffrey Shields**, **Tyler Green**, **J.R. Bradley**, **Kable Hogben** and **Ender Inciarte**.

## More Tid Bits:

**ARCHIE IN BOWLING GREEN ...** Bradley struck out at least one batter in each of his five innings and fanned three of the final four batters he faced. He did not allow a base runner in the second and fifth innings. **Todd Glaesmann** recorded an RBI single off Bradley in the third inning.

**BIG MONEY ...** Bradley signed with the Diamondbacks last August at the deadline for **\$5 million**. This is the most money the Diamondbacks have ever paid a drafted pitcher.

**STELLAR STUFF ...** Bradley's fastball sits between 92-98 MPH and his power curveball comes in at 82-85 MPH. He also has a changeup in his arsenal.

**HAWKS BULLPEN ...** The Silver Hawks bullpen has not given up a run since there was one out in the 7th inning on 4/7/12. Entering today's game, the bullpen has turned in **15.1** straight scoreless innings.

**FORMER HAWKS AROUND BASEBALL ...** **Bobby Borchering** homered and **David Holmberg** earned a win as the **Visalia Rawhide** improved to 4-2 with a 3-1 win against **Modesto**. **Matt Davidson** recorded two more hits in Double-A Mobile's 3-2 win against Pensacola, raising his average to .429 on the season. The **BayBears** are off to a 5-1 start. **Barry Enright** ('07) tossed six innings of shutout baseball and **Ryan Wheeler** doubled for the Triple-A **Reno Aces** (2-4) in a 2-1 loss against **Salt Lake City**.

**FILLING IN AT THIRD ...** As **Mark Haley** continues to recover from and offseason illness, he will begin the season coaching from the dugout. **Luis Urueta** will fill in as third base coach until Haley returns. Urueta is the Arizona Diamondbacks short-season field coordinator.

**WELL REPRESENTED ...** The Silver Hawks opening day roster features **13** players that spent time with the 2011 **Missoula Osprey** of the Pioneer League. Pitchers: **Archie Bradley**, **Jesse Darrah**, **Keith Hessler**, **D.J. Johnson**, **Matt Sample**, **Taylor Siemens** and **Seth Simmons** ... Position Players: **Fidel Pena**, **Josh Parr**, **Chris Ellison**, **Ryan Court**, **Tom Belza** and **Roidany Aguila**.

**THIRD SEASON HAWKS ...** While the Silver Hawks welcome back 10 total players in 2012, **four** of them will be playing in their third season with the Hawks. **Matt Helm** (2010-11), **Ender Inciarte** (2010-11), **Tyson Van Winkle** (2009-10) and **Bobby Stone** (2010-11).

**SILVER HAWKS RECORD WATCH ...** **Ender Inciarte** currently ranks sixth on the Silver Hawks career triples list with 13. **Keon Broxton** is the all-time leader with 21. With 17 career Silver Hawks losses, J.R. Bradley is just four shy of the career loss record of 20 held by **Marc Van Womer**.
