## Overview:

**LAST GAME ... Matt Helm** hit a go-ahead RBI double in the eighth inning to help lift the Silver Hawks to a thrilling 12-10 win against the Beloit Snappers in the first game of a three-game series. The Silver Hawks and Snappers combined for 31 hits.

**UP NEXT ...** The Silver Hawks play the final two games of a three-game series with Beloit before welcoming the **Wisconsin Timber Rattlers** to The Cove for their only visit of the season starting Sunday. After a six-game homestand the Silver Hawks embark on their longest road trip thus far — a six-game trip featuring the **Cedar Rapids Kernels** (April 26-28) and **Quad Cities River Bandits** (April 29-May 1).

**CAREER NIGHT ... Ender Inciarte** recorded a career-high four hits Thursday to raise his batting average **66** points from .205 to .271. His three doubles were the most a Silver Hawk has hit in a game since **Matt Helm** hit three on May 14 of last season against Bowling Green in game one of a double-header.

**RUNS, RUNS, RUNS ...** The **Silver Hawks** and **Snappers** combined for **22** runs in last night's game, the most in any Silver Hawks game this season. The previous high was **11** combined runs on April 15 versus Dayton.

**BEAT THE STREAK ...** With a 2-for-4 in last night's game, **Tom Belza** extended his team-leading active hitting streak (4/13-current) to **seven** games. On Sunday, **Matt Helm's** league-best nine-game hitting streak came to an end. The streak started on April 5. **Michael Freeman** had the Hawks longest hitting streak last season at **15** games.

**ABOUT COACHING STAFF ...** Silver Hawks Field Manager **Mark Haley** will skipper the Hawks for an eighth consecutive season. Haley enters this season with 582 career wins. Haley was named Midwest League Manager of the Year in 2005 and 2008. **Bobby Smith** returns for his second season as the Hawks hitting coach. Smith played in parts of five big league seasons with Tampa Bay. **Wellington Cepeda** is back for his sixth season as the Hawks pitching coach and his ninth in the Dbacks organization.

**CHANGES ABOUND ...** The Silver Hawks are now owned and operated by Swing-Batter-Swing LLC whose sole shareholder is **Andrew T. Berlin** of Chicago. Berlin reached an agreement to buy the team in November and the sale was approved in January. Berlin (\$2.25 Million) and the city of South Bend (\$1.75 Million) have invested about **\$4 million** for renovations at Coveleski Regional Stadium.

**RENOVATIONS ...** Changes at **Coveleski Stadium** include eight new **outdoor suites** and a brand new **home plate suite**. Pre-existing indoor suites are being renovated. A **brick facade** will now cover many of the bare concrete walls inside the stadium. A splash pad is being added beyond the right field wall, the synagogue on William St. is being transformed into the team's new **souvenir store**. A **family fun zone** -- with games and inflatables -- is new behind the left-center field fence.

**BASEBALL AMERICA TOP PROSPECTS ...** Right-hander **Archie Bradley** is ranked the No. 2 prospect in the Diamondbacks organization, according to Baseball America. **Tyler Green** (No. 25), **Jesse Darrah** (No. 26) **J.R. Bradley** (No. 27) and **John Pedrotty** (No. 29) are also on the list.

## More Tid Bits:

**LAST START ...** J.R. Bradley rebounded from his first start and posted six solid innings en route to a 10-1 win against Dayton in the final game of a four-game series. Bradley finished with just two hits allowed — the fewest of his professional career for an outing of six or more innings.

**SCOUTING REPORT ...** From Baseball America: “[J.R.] Bradley projects to have an average fastball and currently pitches at 88-92 MPH on a downhill plane with nice sink. He developed a change up last year that eventually became his best pitch.”

**RECORDS SET ...** With 16 losses in 2011, J.R. Bradley set the Silver Hawks record for single season losses. Marc Van Womer lost 15 games in 1998. Bradley is just three shy of the career loss record of 20 held by Van Womer. Bradley also placed second in single season runs allowed (100), sixth in single season earned runs allowed (79) and third in single season home runs allowed (16).

**MILESTONE WATCH ...** Matt Helm has played in 206 games with the Silver Hawks from 2010-12. Byron Mathews holds the franchise record for career games played with 312 from 1993-95. Helm is 106 away from that with 126 game left in the season.

**DAY-IN, DAY-OUT ...** Matt Helm and Tom Belza have started all 14 games for the Silver Hawks in 2012. Helm played in 127 games during the 2011 season. Daniel Perales played in 136 games in 2007 — a franchise record.

**AFFILIATE ACTION ...** Chris Owings and Keon Broxton each recorded two hits Thursday for High-A Visalia in a losing effort — the Rawhide fell to Rancho Cucamonga 5-1. Yazy Arbelo debuted with Double-A Mobile on Wednesday and is 0-for-6 through two games. A.J. Pollock tallied his first MLB RBI with a sacrifice fly to right field against Atlanta.

**FILLING IN AT THIRD ...** As Mark Haley continues to recover, he will begin the season coaching from the dugout. Luis Urueta will fill in as third base coach until Haley returns. Urueta is the Arizona Diamondbacks short-season field coordinator.

**WELL REPRESENTED ...** The Silver Hawks opening day roster features 13 players that spent time with the 2011 Missoula Osprey of the Pioneer League. Pitchers: Archie Bradley, Jesse Darrah, Keith Hessler, D.J. Johnson, Matt Sample, Taylor Siemens and Seth Simmons ... Position Players: Fidel Pena, Josh Parr, Chris Ellison, Ryan Court, Tom Belza and Roidany Aguila.

**SILVER HAWKS RECORD WATCH ...** Ender Inciarte currently ranks fourth on the Silver Hawks career triples list with 14. Keon Broxton is the all-time leader with 21. With 17 career Silver Hawks losses, J.R. Bradley is just three shy of the career loss record of 20 held by Marc Van Womer.
