Overview:

LAST GAME ... John Pedrotty earned his first win of the season while Marc Bourgeois and Chris Ellison each hit solo home runs in an 8-1 triumph against the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers at Coveleski Stadium. Fidel Pena went 4-for-4 with an RBI and Ender Inciarte extended his hitting streak to six games with a 2-for-4 performance. The Silver Hawks have won a season-high three games in a row.

UP NEXT ... After an off day on Wednesday the Hawks embark on their longest road trip thus far — a six-game trip featuring the Cedar Rapids Kernels (April 26-28) and Quad Cities River Bandits (April 29-May 1). The Hawks begin a seven-game homestand on May 2 when the Bowling Green Hot Rods come to South Bend.

CAREER NIGHT ... Fidel Pena set a career high with four hits on Monday night. Pena was signed as a non-drafted free agent in 2009 and began his professional career that year in the Dominican Summer League. With the four hits, Pena boosted his average by 63 points from .137 to .200. Four different Silver Hawks have posted four-hit games through 18 games; the Silver Hawks had four four-hit games all of last season.

BB | SO RATIO ... Ender Inciarte is the only Silver Hawks hitter with more walks (9) than strikeouts (8). His .408 on-base percentage is a team-high. During his six-game hitting streak, Inciarte has posted five multi-hit games.

BEAT THE STREAK ... With a 1-for-4 in Monday night's game, Tom Belza extended his team-leading active hitting streak (4/13-current) to eight games. Belza's on-base percentage is .407.

ABOUT COACHING STAFF ... Silver Hawks Field Manager Mark Haley will skipper the Hawks for an eighth consecutive season. Haley enters this season with 582 career wins. Haley was named Midwest League Manager of the Year in 2005 and 2008. Bobby Smith returns for his second season as the Hawks hitting coach. Smith played in parts of five big league seasons with Tampa Bay. Wellington Cepeda is back for his sixth season as the Hawks pitching coach and his ninth in the Dbacks organization.

CHANGES ABOUND ... The Silver Hawks are now owned and operated by Swing-Batter-Swing LLC whose sole shareholder is Andrew T. Berlin of Chicago. Berlin reached an agreement to buy the team in November and the sale was approved in January. Berlin (\$2.25 Million) and the city of South Bend (\$1.75 Million) have invested about \$4 million for renovations at Coveleski Regional Stadium.

RENOVATIONS ... Changes at Coveleski Stadium include eight new outdoor suites and a brand new home plate suite. Pre-existing indoor suites are being renovated. A brick facade will now cover many of the bare concrete walls inside the stadium. A splash pad is being added beyond the right field wall, the synagogue on William St. is being transformed into the team's new souvenir store. A family fun zone -- with games and inflatables -- is new behind the left-center field fence.

BASEBALL AMERICA TOP PROSPECTS ... Right-hander Archie Bradley is ranked the No. 2 prospect in the Diamondbacks organization, according to Baseball America. Tyler Green (No. 25), Jesse Darrah (No. 26) J.R. Bradley (No. 27) and John Pedrotty (No. 29) are also on the list.

More Tid Bits:

LAST START ... When Darrah exited after the top of the fifth, the Silver Hawks were leading 8-4. South Bend added another run in the bottom of the fifth to make it 9-4, but the Snappers rallied to take a 10-9 lead against the Hawks bullpen. The Silver Hawks eventually beat Beloit 12-10 but Darrah got his first no decision of the season. Darrah's trouble inning was the fifth, where he gave up three runs on four hits.

LONG BALLS ... Darrah has surrendered a long ball in each of his last two starts and has accounted for two of three the Silver Hawks have allowed this season. As a pitching staff, the Silver Hawks have allowed the fewest home runs in the MWL.

STRIKEOUT STUFF ... Last spring, Darrah set the Fresno Pacific record with 101 strikeouts in 89 innings. He followed that up by fanning 68 in 59.1 innings with Missoula.

NAIA PRIDE ... Darrah was the first NAIA pitcher selected in the 2011 Draft. The eighth rounder signed for **\$105,000** after playing collegiately at **Sacramento State** and **Fresno Pacific**.

MILESTONE WATCH ... **Matt Helm** has played in **210** games with the Silver Hawks from 2010-12. **Byron Mathews** holds the franchise record for career games played with **312** from 1993-95. Helm is **102** away from that with **122** game left in the season.

DAY-IN, DAY-OUT ... **Matt Helm** is the only Hawk to start all 18 games for the Silver Hawks in 2012. Helm played in 127 games during the 2011 season. **Daniel Perales** played in 136 games in 2007 — a franchise record.

AFFILIATE ACTION ... **Chris Owings** went 2-for-4 with a pair of doubles for the Rawhide in a 6-5 10-inning loss against Modesto. In six games with Double-A Mobile, **Yazy Arbelo** is 0-for-16 with six strikeouts. **Wade Miley** tossed six shutout inning for Arizona and got his second win as the Dbacks beat the Phillies 9-5.

FILLING IN AT THIRD ... As **Mark Haley** continues to recover, he will begin the season coaching from the dugout. **Luis Urueta** will fill in as third base coach until Haley returns. Urueta is the Arizona Diamondbacks short-season field coordinator.

WELL REPRESENTED ... The Silver Hawks opening day roster featured **13** players that spent time with the 2011 **Missoula Osprey** of the Pioneer League. Pitchers: **Archie Bradley**, **Jesse Darrah**, **Keith Hessler**, **D.J. Johnson**, **Matt Sample**, **Taylor Siemens** and **Seth Simmons** ... Position Players: **Fidel Pena**, **Josh Parr**, **Chris Ellison**, **Ryan Court**, **Tom Belza** and **Roidany Aguila**.

SILVER HAWKS RECORD WATCH ... **Ender Inciarte** currently ranks fourth on the Silver Hawks career triples list with 14. **Keon Broxton** is the all-time leader with 21. With 18 career Silver Hawks losses, J.R. Bradley is just two shy of the career loss record of 20 held by **Marc Van Womer**.
