## Overview:

**LAST GAME ...** The Silver Hawks dropped their second straight game to the Great Lakes Loons, this time by a 6-4 final in 10 innings. The Silver Hawks built a 4-0 second inning lead but did not score the rest of the way. The Silver Hawks lost for the first time in five extra inning games this season.

**UP NEXT ...** The Hawks continue a four-game set against the Great Lakes Loons to wrap up a seven-game homestand. The Silver Hawks hit the road for seven straight beginning on Wednesday with a three-game series against the Fort Wayne TinCaps. The trip concludes with a four-game set against the Bowling Green Hot Rods in Kentucky.

**(UN)FRIENDLY CONFINES ...** The Great Lakes Loons are now 7-1 at Coveleski Stadium dating back to last season. The Loons are 13-4 at The Cove dating back to 2010. At The Cove, the Loons were 6-3 in '10, 5-1 in '11 and 2-0 this season.

**FIRST TIME FOR EVERYTHING ...** The Silver Hawks lost in extra innings Sunday for the first time in 2012. They also lost for the first time in 13 games this season when holding a lead after seven innings.

**LONG BALL, AT LONG LAST ...** Matt Helm hit a two-run home run in the first inning Sunday for his first round-tripper since August 31, 2011 at Fort Wayne. Helm hit eight home runs in 2011 and now has 17 in his professional career.

**TRIPLE, TRIPLE, TRIPLE ...** Gerson Montilla has hit a triple in his last three games, the only three triples he has hit this season. Montilla hit two triples in 66 games last season for South Bend.

**ABOUT COACHING STAFF ...** Silver Hawks Field Manager Mark Haley will skipper the Hawks for an eighth consecutive season. Haley was named Midwest League Manager of the Year in 2005 and 2008. Bobby Smith returns for his second season as the Hawks hitting coach. Wellington Cepeda is back for his sixth season as the Hawks pitching coach and his ninth in the Dbacks organization.

**CHANGES AROUND ...** The Silver Hawks are now owned and operated by Swing-Batter-Swing LLC whose sole shareholder is Andrew T. Berlin of Chicago. Berlin reached an agreement to buy the team in November and the sale was approved in January. Berlin (\$2.25 Million) and the city of South Bend (\$1.75 Million) have invested about \$4 million for renovations at Coveleski Regional Stadium.

**RENOVATIONS ...** Changes at Coveleski Stadium include eight new outdoor suites and a brand new home plate suite. Pre-existing indoor suites are being renovated. A brick facade will now cover many of the bare concrete walls inside the stadium. A splash pad is being added beyond the right field wall, the synagogue on William St. is being transformed into the team's new souvenir store. A family fun zone -- with games and inflatables -- is new behind the left-center field fence.

**BASEBALL AMERICA TOP PROSPECTS ...** Right-hander Archie Bradley is ranked the No. 2 prospect in the Diamondbacks organization, according to Baseball America. Tyler Green (No. 25), Jesse Darrah (No. 26) J.R. Bradley (No. 27) and John Pedrotty (No. 29) are also on the list.

Notes on Bradley:

**LAST START ...** J.R. got a no decision in his last start on May 2 against the Bowling Green Hot Rods and has now allowed just one earned run over his last 10 innings. Bradley held the Hot Rods scoreless until **Matt Rice** hit a solo home run to lead off the fifth inning. The first three reached against Bradley in the first inning but **Ryan Brett** was caught stealing and the Hot Rods did not score.

**SCOUTING REPORT ...** From Baseball America: "[J.R.] Bradley projects to have an average fastball and currently pitches at 88-92 MPH on a downhill plane with nice sink. He developed a change up last year that eventually became his best pitch."

**RECORDS SET ...** With 16 losses in 2011, **J.R. Bradley** set the Silver Hawks record for single season losses. **Marc Van Womer** lost 15 games in 1998. Bradley is just two shy of the *career* loss record of 20 held by Van Womer. Bradley also placed second in single season runs allowed (100), sixth in single season earned runs allowed (79) and third in single season home runs allowed (16).

More Tid Bits:

**DOUBLE TROUBLE ...** With 10 doubles this season, **Matt Helm** has passed **Olmedo Saenz** and is now fifth on the Silver Hawks career doubles list with **44**. **Ender Inciarte** has **37** career Hawks doubles, and is two away from tying **Charlie Poe** for tenth all-time.

**200-HIT CLUB ...** With **201** career Silver Hawks hits, **Ender Inciarte** is now tied with Ed Smith for tenth all-time on the Silver Hawks career hits list. With two hits Sunday afternoon, **Matt Helm** now has **200** career Silver Hawks hits. Nilson Robledo tallied **334** hits from 1991-95.

**DAY-IN, DAY-OUT ...** **Matt Helm** is the only Hawk to start all **30** games for the Silver Hawks in 2012. Helm played in 127 games during the 2011 season. **Daniel Peralas** played in 136 games in 2007 — a franchise record.

**FORMER HAWKS IN ACTION ...** **Matt Davidson** and **Yazy Arbelo** each notched RBI doubles as the Double-A Mobile BayBears defeated the Jacksonville Suns 11-0. **Barry Enright** allowed just two earned runs on four hits over 6.1 innings for Triple-A Reno and ran his record to 4-1.

**SILVER HAWKS RECORD WATCH ...** **Ender Inciarte** currently ranks third on the Silver Hawks career triples list with 15. **Keon Broxton** is the all-time leader with 21. Inciarte tripled in the tenth inning on Friday night against Bowling Green.
