Overview:

LAST GAME ... The South Bend Silver Hawks lost the opening game of a four-game series with the Bowling Green Hot Rods by a 4-3 final. The game was called after six innings Saturday due to inclement weather in Bowling Green. **Josh Sale** provided the big hit of the game for the Hot Rods, a three-run home run in the fourth inning.

UP NEXT ... The Silver Hawks continue a seven-game road swing Monday with the second and third games of a four-game set against the Bowling Green Hot Rods in Kentucky. The Hawks return home on May 16 to begin a three-game series with the Lake County Captains. It is the first meeting between the Hawks and Captains in '12.

RAIN SHORTENED GAMES ... Saturday night's rain-shortened loss was the Hawks first rain-shortened game since July 11, 2011, when the Silver Hawks defeated the Dayton Dragons 3-2 in six innings. **J.R. Bradley** started that game and got the win.

CLOSE GAMES ... Saturday's 4-3 loss was the Silver Hawks first one-run loss in 2012. The Silver Hawks are 7-1 in one-run games this season and have the third most one-run wins in the MWL trailing only Great Lakes who has 11 and Wisconsin who has eight.

HOT | COLD ... The Silver Hawks as a team are hitting .215 over the last ten games. **Josh Parr** is now 0-for-26 in his last 8 games. **Parr's** last hit was on May 2 vs. Bowling Green. **Fidel Pena** is hitting .313 (5-for-16) in his last five games.

GAME-ENDER ... **Ender Inciarte** hit the eventual game-winner on Thursday night against the Fort Wayne TinCaps. **Inciarte** hit a game-winning RBI infield single in the 10th inning on April 12 vs. Dayton. **Inciarte** also hit a walk-off RBI single in a 2-1 win against Wisconsin on April 22.

ABOUT COACHING STAFF ... Silver Hawks Field Manager **Mark Haley** will skipper the Hawks for an eighth consecutive season. **Haley** was named Midwest League Manager of the Year in 2005 and 2008. **Bobby Smith** returns for his second season as the Hawks hitting coach. **Wellington Cepeda** is back for his sixth season as the Hawks pitching coach and his ninth in the Dbacks organization.

CHANGES AROUND ... The Silver Hawks are now owned and operated by Swing-Batter-Swing LLC whose sole shareholder is **Andrew T. Berlin** of Chicago. **Berlin** reached an agreement to buy the team in November and the sale was approved in January. **Berlin** (\$2.25 Million) and the city of South Bend (\$1.75 Million) have invested about \$4 million for renovations at Coveleski Regional Stadium.

RENOVATIONS ... Changes at Coveleski Stadium include eight new outdoor suites and a brand new home plate suite. Pre-existing indoor suites are being renovated. A brick facade will now cover many of the bare concrete walls inside the stadium. A splash pad is being added beyond the right field wall, the synagogue on William St. is being transformed into the team's new souvenir store. A family fun zone -- with games and inflatables -- is new behind the left-center field fence.

BASEBALL AMERICA TOP PROSPECTS ... Right-hander **Archie Bradley** is ranked the No. 2 prospect in the Diamondbacks organization, according to Baseball America. **Tyler Green** (No. 25), **Jesse Darrah** (No. 26) **J.R. Bradley** (No. 27) and **John Pedrotty** (No. 29) are also on the list.

Notes on Archie Bradley:

LAST APPEARANCE ... Bradley allowed a career-high five runs — three earned — on four hits over four innings against Great Lakes on May 8. The four innings worked was the shortest of Bradley's seven starts this season. The Loons scored three runs against Bradley in the third inning and two more in the fourth inning. Seven men came to the plate in the third inning. Bradley surrendered his first career home run — a solo home run from **Pedro Guerrero** in the third inning.

VS. BOWLING GREEN ... Bradley makes his third start against the Bowling Green Hot Rods. Through ten innings, the Hot Rods are hitting .143 against Bradley and have struck out 11 times. Bradley is 1-1 with a 1.80 earned run average.

CALLED UP, SORT OF ... During spring training, Kirk Gibson invited Bradley to supervise big league camp. They told him to take notice of Ian Kennedy's preparation. Kennedy, 27, won 21 games for the Dbacks in 2011.

LEADING THE PACK ... Bradley currently holds the best opponents batting average (.114) in the league. He also has the second most wins (4) and the second best strikeout/9 inning ratio among starters at 9.77.

More Tid Bits:

DOUBLE TROUBLE ... With 12 doubles this season, **Matt Helm** has passed **Olmedo Saenz** and is now tied for fourth all-time on the Silver Hawks career doubles list with **46**. **Ender Inciarte** has **38** career Hawks doubles, and is tied with **Charlie Poe** for tenth all-time.

200-HIT CLUB ... With **206** career Silver Hawks hits, **Ender Inciarte** is now now tenth all-time on the Silver Hawks career hits list. **Matt Helm** has **207** career Silver Hawks hits and is currently tied for 9th all-time.

DAY-IN, DAY-OUT ... **Matt Helm** is the only Hawk to start all **36** games for the Silver Hawks this season. Helm and Wisconsin's Jason Rogers are the only two players in the MWL who have played in 36 games. **Daniel Peralas** played in 136 games in 2007 — a franchise record.

FORMER HAWKS IN ACTION ... **Matt Davidson** hit a two-run walk-off home run Sunday in the tenth inning as the Mobile BayBears defeated the Chattanooga Lookouts 7-5. Davidson added another two-run home run in the eighth inning.

SILVER HAWKS RECORD WATCH ... **Ender Inciarte** currently ranks third on the Silver Hawks career triples list with 15. **Keon Broxton** is the all-time leader with 21. Inciarte tripled in the tenth inning on Friday night against Bowling Green.

Game Two Starter:

RHP - JEFF SHIELDS ... Shields was hit with his fourth loss of the season on Wednesday at Parkview Field in Fort Wayne. Shields went 4.2 innings and allowed five earned runs on five hits with four walks and three strikeouts. The four walks issued were a career-high from Shields. The TinCaps scored four runs on three hits plus three walks in the fourth inning, knocking the right-hander out of the game.

Notes on Shields:

LAST APPEARANCE ... Shields was hit with his fourth loss of the season on Wednesday at Parkview Field in Fort Wayne. Shields went 4.2 innings and allowed five earned runs on five hits with four walks and three strikeouts. The four walks issued were a career-high from Shields. The TinCaps scored four runs on three hits plus three walks in the fourth inning, knocking the right-hander out of the game.

VS. BOWLING GREEN ... Shields has pitched twice against the Hot Rods in 2012 and is 0-1 with a 3.00 ERA in 12 innings against Bowling Green. The Hot Rods are hitting .340 against Shields and have 16 hits in the 12 innings.

QUALITY STARTS ... Shields has turned in a "quality start" in four of his seven starts, the highest total among Silver Hawks pitchers. He is the only pitcher to go seven inning and has done so four different times.

DOUBLE PLAYS ... Shields has induced eight double plays this season, the most on the Silver Hawks pitching staff. The next nearest is John Pedrotty who has induced five. Five of Shield's eight double plays have come against Bowling Green. The Hot Rods as a team have rolled into 34 double plays, the most in the Midwest League.
