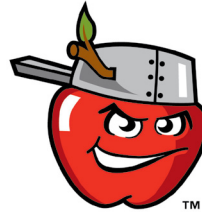

Overview:

LAST GAME ... The South Bend Silver Hawks fell behind 8-0 Thursday and dropped a second consecutive game against the TinCaps, this time by a 14-8 final. The 22 combined runs matches the most runs scored in a Silver Hawks game this season. The TinCaps scored a season-high 14 runs.

UP NEXT ... The Hawks and Fort Wayne TinCaps finish off a three-game series on Friday night. Tomorrow, the Silver Hawks begin a seven-game road trip, featuring four games with the Great Lakes Loons and three with the Dayton Dragons.

FALLING BACK DOWN ... The Silver Hawks are just one game above .500 for the first time since entering play with a record of 9-8 on April 23 versus the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers. The Silver Hawks have not been below .500 since entering play on April 21 with a record of 7-8.

WALKS & RUNS ... The Silver Hawks allowed season-highs in walks (9) and runs allowed (14) Thursday against Fort Wayne. The Silver Hawks also walked nine in a 5-3 win against Bowling Green on May 3 and allowed 14 runs in a 14-3 loss against Quad Cities on April 30.

SIX OR MORE RUNS ... The Silver Hawks lost for the first time in 11 games this season when scoring *six or more* runs. Twice the Silver Hawks had scored five runs in a losing effort.

HAWK KILLER... Fort Wayne's Austin Hedges is hitting .308 versus the Silver Hawks in eight games and has swatted two home runs and knocked in nine runs. Hedges hit a grand slam at Coveleski Stadium on Thursday.

ABOUT COACHING STAFF ... Silver Hawks Field Manager Mark Haley will skipper the Hawks for an eighth consecutive season. Haley was named Midwest League Manager of the Year in 2005 and 2008. Bobby Smith returns for his second season as the Hawks hitting coach. Wellington Cepeda is back for his sixth season as the Hawks pitching coach and his ninth in the Dbacks organization.

CHANGES AROUND ... The Silver Hawks are now owned and operated by Swing-Batter-Swing LLC whose sole shareholder is Andrew T. Berlin of Chicago. Berlin reached an agreement to buy the team in November and the sale was approved in January. Berlin (\$2.25 Million) and the city of South Bend (\$1.75 Million) have invested about \$4 million for renovations at Coveleski Regional Stadium.

RENOVATIONS ... Changes at Coveleski Stadium include eight new outdoor suites and a brand new home plate suite. Pre-existing indoor suites are being renovated. A brick facade now covers many of the bare concrete walls inside the stadium. A splash pad is being added beyond the right field wall, the synagogue on William St. is being transformed into the team's new souvenir store. A family fun zone -- with games and inflatables -- is new behind the left-center field fence.

BASEBALL AMERICA TOP PROSPECTS ... Right-hander Archie Bradley is ranked the No. 2 prospect in the Diamondbacks organization, according to Baseball America. Tyler Green (No. 25), Jesse Darrah (No. 26) J.R. Bradley (No. 27) and John Pedrotty (No. 29) are also on the list.

Notes on Archie Bradley:

LAST START ... Bradley allowed season-highs in earned runs (4) and hits allowed (6) against West Michigan on May 19. The first six batters Bradley faced in the first inning reached safely against him. The Whitecaps scored two runs on three hits in the first inning. Tom Belza's outfield assist prevented further damage in the frame. Bradley recorded seven or more strikeouts in his first three starts, but has not reached that plateau in his last six outings.

VS. FORT WAYNE ... Bradley turned in his longest outing of 2012 against Fort Wayne on April 11, turning in a career-best six innings. The TinCaps got their lone run in the first inning against Bradley with the help of a pair of walks. The first-rounder struck out the side in the second inning.

CALLED UP, SORT OF ... During spring training, Kirk Gibson invited Bradley to supervise big league camp. They told him to take notice of Ian Kennedy's preparation. Kennedy, 27, won 21 games for the Dbacks in 2011.

LEADING THE PACK ... Bradley currently holds the best opponents batting average (.132) in the league. He also has the most wins (6) and the second best strikeout/9 inning ratio among starters at 9.60.

More Tid Bits:

INCIARTE'S CAREER MARKS ... With 215 career Silver Hawks hits, **Ender Inciarte** is now ninth all-time on the Silver Hawks career hits list. **Ender Inciarte** has 41 career Hawks doubles, and is tied for eighth all-time. Inciarte is sixth all-time with 126 runs scored. **Ender Inciarte** currently places third on the Silver Hawks career triples list with 16. **Keon Broxton** is the all-time leader with 21.

HELM'S MILESTONES ... With 14 doubles this season, **Matt Helm** is now fourth all-time on the Silver Hawks career doubles list with 48. Helm has 216 career Silver Hawks hits and is currently tied for seventh all-time. Helm is seventh all-time with 106 RBIs; sixth all-time with 854 at-bats; eighth all-time with 239 games played; eighth all-time in extra base hits with 63; second all-time with 273 strikeouts (277 all-time record).
